FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – VENERABLE LUCIA – THE LONELY MARIAN APOSTLE – PT. 8



It was becoming more and more difficult for Lucia to remain in Fátima. The crowds of curious individuals seemed to grow with each passing day. Because of this, some concerned people asked Maria Rosa to let Lucia go away for a while. Lucia's father had been opposed to this idea, but now that he had died, Maria Rosa was more open to the idea. With the aid of Fr. Formigao, Lucia went to Lisbon from July 7 to August 6, 1920. While there, she was enrolled in a private school by Dona Assuncao Avelar, but people quickly recognized her. Avelar was warned that the government officials were looking for Lucia and that they were in danger. Fr. Formigao's sister took Lucia away to Fr. Formigao's house where she was told to stay inside, away from the windows so as not to be seen. Unfortunately, people learned she was there, as they saw her at Mass one day, and so she was returned to Aljustrel on August 12, 1920.

The issue was still how to protect Lucia and the answer came from the new bishop of Leiria, Bishop Jose Alves Correia da Silva, who was installed on August 5, 1920. The bishop's plan was to send Lucia to Porto (in the northern part of Portugal) to go to school. The motives of the bishop were genuine, in that Lucia was the last living visionary, and he wanted to protect her from all the unpleasant and ill-intentioned interrogations she still endured. So at 2:00 a.m. on June 16, 1921, the 14-year-old left Aljustrel for Leiria. Before she left, she made a few stops to the graves of Francisco and her father (Jacinta was buried in Lisbon at the time). She went to the Cova da Iria, the Cabeco (where they first saw the angel), the well and Valinhos and all the places associated with the Heavenly visits of 1916 and 1917.

In her memoirs, she explains the decision to go to Porto: "Precisely because in Porto I didn't know anyone... it was fitting that I go there. To avoid being recognized I would change my name (which was changed to Maria das Dores), and I would not say where I was from or whose daughter I was, nor would I speak about any other person in my family. Only the lady to whom the bishop entrusted me and the superior of the school where I would go would know who I was - no one else. So when people wouldn't start to go there to find me, want to speak to me, to disturb me and take the time I had to devote to study."

Lucia's mother would visit once a year. In the last year that she lived in Porto, the bishop invited Lucia and her mother to Quinta da Formigueria in Braga, where he confirmed Lucia. Lucia took this opportunity in Braga at the bishop's place to ask her mother if she could enter the religious life. Her mother responded, "My daughter, I don't know anything about that kind of life. I will ask the bishop." Lucia describes the response of the bishop, "My mother came back after a long conversation. She was happy to tell me yes, on the condition that I would let her know if I wasn't happy and it didn't work out."

On October 24, 1925, she entered the Institute of the Sisters of St. Dorothy as a postulant in the convent in Tuy, Spain, not far from the Portuguese border.

During these years, she would continue to receive private revelations explanatory of the message of Fátima. She made her first vows on October 3, 1928, and her perpetual vows on October 3, 1934, receiving the name Sister Mary of the Sorrowful Mother.

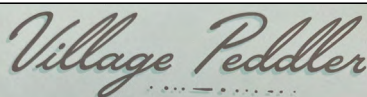
