OUR LADY OF FATIMA

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS - ST. FRANCISCO THE GENTLE SOUL - PT. 1



In the opening pages of Sr. Lucia's fourth memoirs, she describes Francisco by stating, "Apart from his features and his practice of virtue, Francisco did not seem at all to be Jacinta's brother. Unlike her, he was neither capricious nor vivacious. On the contrary, he was quiet and submissive by nature. When we were at play and he won the game, if anyone made a point of denying him his rights as winner, he yielded without more ado and merely said: "You think you won? That's alright! I don't mind. He showed no love for dancing, as Jacinta did; he much preferred playing the flute while others danced."

Lucia goes on to tell a story of a handkerchief that someone brought him from the seaside. It had a picture of Our Lady of Nazare. The Shrine of Our Lady of Nazareth, known in Portugal as Nossa Senhora da Nazare, is found in the village of Nazare on the Atlantic coast in Portugal. The village is named after this miraculous statue of the Blessed Mother and the Christ Child that was brought to the area many centuries ago. According to tradition, this miraculous image was carved by the hands of Saint Joseph, the foster father of Christ, while in the very presence of the Infant Jesus and the Mother of God. Later, the faces and hands of the images were painted by Saint Luke the Evangelist. This remarkable image is still preserved in a church where it can be viewed by anyone, and the story surrounding it is a fascinating one. As the handkerchief was passed around for all to see, it came up missing. Sr. Lucia found it in the pocket of another boy, who claimed that it was his, that he also had someone bring him one from the seaside. Francisco's response was, "Let him have it! What does a handkerchief matter to me."

We contrast Sr. Lucia's overall impression of Francisco by that of his father. "His father said: 'He was more courageous than Jacinta. He didn't always have as much patience; and often, for small reason, he would run around like a young bull calf. He was anything but a coward. He would go out at night, alone in the dark, without a sign of fear. He played with lizards and snakes..."






